AUSTRALIAN RADIO PUBLICATIONS BEFORE 1950 AN UPDATE.

In the HRSA Newsletter⁽¹⁾ and Amateur Radio magazine⁽²⁾ Chris Long published an article titled "Australian Radio Journals Before 1939 - A Survey". I have finally collated my own collection and other data so the following is a brief summary of a comprehensive booklet⁽³⁾ totalling over 60 pages, with updates, additional publications and a few corrections. I have included books published in Australia that might be of interest to collectors and members, but not professional journals, or text books, valve data books etc. as these seem to be readily available and well known. I have concentrated on publications with some technical content and have not included magazines which were purely lists of weekly programs and biographies of radio announcers. I am indebted to Dave Handscomb, VK6ATE, who supplied much of the information on West Australian publications.

MAGAZINES and PERIODICAL PUBLICATIONS.

AMATEUR RADIO. Monthly started October 1933 and continues. Melbourne.

A.R.T.S. & **PATENTS BULLETIN.** Irregular. No. 1 on 9/8/1934 to No. 144 during 1949. New series No.1 in 1957 to No. 14 in 1960. Sydney.

AUSTRALASIAN ELECTRICAL TIMES. Monthly started 27/1/1922. Changed to AUSTRALASIAN ELECTRICAL AND RADIO TIMES with Vol.15 No.1 of February, 1936. Last issue Vol.31 No.1 of July/August, 1951. Melbourne.

AUSTRALASIAN RADIO WORLD. Monthly started May 1936. Absorbed by RADIO AND ELECTRONICS (New Zealand) in December 1950. Combined in AUSTRALIAN RADIO and ELECTRONICS with the January 1951 issue. The Australian magazine ceased sometime after the last issue seen, Vol.16 No.3 of October 1951 and the New Zealand edition was sold here through to the 1960's. Sydney, Melbourne, New Zealand. See also R & E Digest.

AUSTRALIAN SHORT WAVE HANDBOOK Annual 1947 to 1950. A follow-on to the Wireless Weekly.

CALL-SIGN BOOK AND TECHNICAL REVIEW which had been published in 1938. Sydney,

AUSTRALASIAN WIRELESS REVIEW. Monthly from January 1923 until September 1925 when it was absorbed into NSW **WIRELESS NEWS** from the same publisher. Sydney.

AUSTRALIAN BROADCASTING COMPANY. Irregular leaflets circa 1930. This company was formed in 1929 to manage the national stations for the government and published a number of small leaflets to assist listeners, such as how to erect antennae, tune stations etc. Melbourne.

AUSTRALIAN BROADCASTING COMPANY YEAR BOOK Annual 1929, 1930. The company had a three year contract and published a year book in 1930 (1929 edition) which gave details of the events and achievements during the year. I do not know if a 1930 (print in 1931) Year Bock was printed. Melbourne.

THE AUSTRALIAN POSTAL ELECTRICIANS' UNION JOURNAL. Monthly started 1915. Also known as The Australian Postal Electrician. In 1942 it became the TELE-TECHNICIAN and continues. Melbourne.

AUSTRALIAN RADIO NEWS AND FILM REVIEW. Weekly started 21/5/1932. The name changed to **AUSTRALIAN RADIO NEWS** with Voll No.34 of January 1933 and then alter 15/6/1934, Vol.3 No.109 it was absorbed into die Bulletin of 20/6/1934 which then printed a wireless Segment. Sydney.

AUSTRALIAN OFFICIAL RADIO SERVICE MANUAL or **A.O.R.S.M.** Annual. There were 13 volumes and several editions with paper or stiff covers. Brisbane.

AUSTRALIAN RADIO & TV NEWS. Monthly started May[.] 1949. Sydney.

A.W.A. RADIO GUIDE. Annual 1926 to 1929. Sydney.

A.W.A. TECHNICAL REVIEW. Non-linally quarterly but in fact irregular. Started March 1935. Ceased September 1977. Sydney.

BOYS WIRELESS NEWS. Weekly started 11/10/1924. Changed to THE WIRELESS NEWS on 28/2/25 and then to NEW SOUTH WALES WIRELESS NEWS on 28/3/25. Absorbed Australasian Wireless Review on 3/10/25 but appears to have ceased alter Vo1.3 No.3 of 31/10/25. Sydney.

THE BROADCAST BULLETIN. Weekly circa 1926, from Queensland.

THE BROADCASTER (W.A.). Weekly started 7/4/1934. Incorporated in the Weekend Mail in 1935. Perth.

BROADCASTING BUSINESS. Weekly started 5/9/1934. A Mingay publication. Changed to fortnightly and to COMMERCIAL BROADCASTING incorporating BROADCASTING BUSINESS on 6/7/39, Vol.8 No.1 then reverted to BROADCASTING BUSINESS incorporating COMMERCIAL BROADCASTING on 28/11/46, Vol.15 No.10. It became ADVERTISING BUSINESS incorporating BROADCASTING BUSINESS on 1/4/48, Vol.17 No.3 and ceased on 29/4/48. Sydney.

BROADCASTING BUSINESS YEAR BOOK of AUSTRALIA. Annual 1935 to 1939. Published by Mingay Publications and also known as BROADCASTING BUSINESS ANNUAL. Sydney.

BROADCASTING BUSINESS QUARTERLY. Quartedy started October 1938 by Mingay. It became **COMMERCIAL BROADCASTING RATE BOOK** in 1939 but ceased late 1939 due to WW2. Sydney.

THE BROADCAST YEAR BOOK and Radio Listeners Annual of Australia 1934. Sydney.

CQ. Monthly started December 1927, ceased about December 1930. Sydney.

ELECTRICAL ENGINEER OF AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND. Started 15/4/24, changed name to ELECTRICAL ENGINEER AND MERCHANDISER on 15/4/31, Vol.8 No. 1. Then became ELECTRICAL ENGINEER with Vol.34 No.1 of 15/4/57. Melbourne.

ELECTRICAL & RADIO TRADER OF AUSTRALIAStartetl about March 1930 and continued till at least 1939.
Sydney.

ERDA. Started January 1930 and became the **ERDA JOURNAL** from Vol.38 No.3 in April 1966. It was the journal of the Electrical and Radio Development Association of NSW. Sydney.

EXPERIMENTAL RADIO and **BROADCAST NEWS**. Started 1/8/1924 and changed name to **RADIO BROADCAST** in March 1925, Vol.1 No.8. In August '25 absorbed the Radio Experimenter & Broadcaster. Ceased with the April 1927 issue alter missing isolated issues. In June 1927 a totally different publication in a newspaper

format titled **RADIO BROADCAST** appeared but it is hard to determine if it was from the saure publishers. Melbourne.

THE GULCHVIEW GAZETTE. circa 1928-1930, Queensland.

HOBBIES ILLUSTRATED. Monthly started June 1945, continued into and 1950's. Sydney.

THE HOME CRAFTSMAN. Started September 1923. In July 1924 it was absorbed into REAL ESTATE AND HOME JOURNAL which bad also started in September 1923 as REAL ESTATE FOR THE HOME BUILDER, from the same publisher. Melbourne.

THE HOMECRAFT MAGAZINE. Monthly started June 1925, ceased October 1926 to be replaced by POPULAR HOBBIES in November 1926. There was no connection with THE HOME CRAFTSMAN. Melbourne.

INTERNATIONAL RADIO NEWS. Monthly started pre-1933 and continued past 1946. Sydney.

LISTENER'S WEEKLY & SCREEN NEWS. Weekly circa 1935? Adelaide.

THE LISTENER IN Started 10/1/1925 in Melbourne. To cater for NSW there was THE NSW LISTENER IN edition. In June 1929 it absorbed POPULAR RADIO AND AVIATION. The name changed to LISTENER IN TV on 10/9/1955, Vol.31 No.37 and then after the April 1976, Vol.49 No.16 issue it changed to TV SCENE with a new Vol.1 No.1 for May 1976. Melbourne.

THE LISTENER IN HANDBOOKS. Melbourne. Issued from about 1928 through to 1947 as follows:-

RECORDING

MODERN SETS. An annual in 1931 and 1932 but then changed to MODERN SETS MONTHLY which started in June 1932. Ceased May 1934 and seems to have missed issues of July, September and December 1933. Published by same company as POPULAR HOBBIES. Melbourne.

OCEAN NEWS. See WIRELESS NEWS.

ON THE AIR. Weekly started 14/10/1933 and ceased sometime after last copy seen 9/12/33. Sydney.

PHILIPS BULLETIN. Irregular but approximately quarterly started 15/8/1927 continued into early 1930's. Sydney.

PHILIPS TECHNICAL COMMUNICATION. Irregular, appears to have started in 1932. Volume 1 contains No.1 to No.33, Volume 2 is No.34 to 55 and volume 3 includes No.56 to 65. Later numbered as T.C. No.xx where T.C. stood for technical Communication. Not issued during latter part of WW2 and recommenced in January 1946 with new Volume 1 with 8 to 10 issues per year. From 1949 they were no longer dated but continued till at least 1955. Sydney.

PHILIPS RESEARCH REPORTS. Quarterly started November 1945.

PHILIPS TECHNICAL REVIEW. Monthly started 1936. Ceased during WW2 and recommenced January 1946 with Vol.8 No. 1. Continued till at least 1970 Vol.31.

POPULAR HOBBIES. Monthly to replace the HOMECRAFT MAGAZINE. Started 15/11/1926 but from February 1927 issued on first of month. Ceased about June 1932. The HOBBIES ANNUAL comprised the first 12 issues of POPULAR HOBBIES (1926-1927). The same publishers issued MODERN SETS MONTHLY which ran from 1932 to 1934. Melbourne.

POPULAR RADIO WEEKLY. Weekly started 25/2/1925. Ceased on 13/6/28, Vol.4 No.I7 but replaced by POPULAR RADIO MONTHLY. Melbourne.

POPULAR RADIO MONTHLY. Monthly started June 1928 to replace POPULAR RADIO WEEKLY. The name changed to POPULAR RADIO AND AVIATION in November 1928 and after May 1929, Voll No.12 was incorporated in the LISTENER IN. Melbourne.

QUEENSLAND ELECTRICAL AND RADIO WORLD. Monthly started in January 1936 (I think). It became ELECTRICAL & RADIO WORLD probably in 1938 and may have then become AUSTRALIAN ELECTRICAL & RADIO WORLD and continued until at least September 1955. Brisbiiiie.

QUEENSLAND RADIO NEWS. Monthly started 2/2/25 and continued to at-least 1934.

QTC. Monthly started July 1927. Ceased November 1931, Vol.5 No.53 but was recommenced about 1955 and continues. Brisbane.

RADIO and HOBBIES IN AUSTRALIA. Monthly started April 1939 from the publishers of WIRELESS WEEKLY. In February 1955 changed to RADIO, TELEVISION AND HOBBIES then in April 1965 became ELECTRONICS AUSTRALIA. After taking over ELECTRONICS TODAY INTERNATIONAL in 1990 it became ELECTRONICS AUSTRALIA with ETI and continues. Sydney.

RADIO BROADCAST. See EXPERIMENTAL RADIO AND BROADCAST NEWS.

RADIO BROADCAST BUREAU BULLETIN. The only reference found is that in 1928 it included the catalogue of the 1928 Radio and Electrical Exhibition. Sydney.

RADIO CALL. Weekly started 15/7/1937. With the issue of 5/5/43 the name changed to SOUTH AUSTRALIAN RADIO CALL but on 31/7/47 it changed back to RADIO CALL. The issue of 10/9/52 became RADIO CALL with HOME & SPORT MAGAZINE but then it changed to RADIO CALL HOME AND SPORT on 5/8/53. It changed back AGAIN to RADIO CALL on 9/2/55. On 26/6/57 it became MIDWEEK & RADIO CALL and finally ceased after the 4/9/57 issue. Adelaide.

RADIO DIAGRAM & INTERMEDIATE FREQUENCY INDEX Published 1940. 1941. 1947 by Mingay as an index to circuits shown in the AUSTRALIAN OFFICIAL RADIO SERVICE MANUALS plus others from various Mingay publications from 1933 to 1945. Sydney.

RADIO AND ELECTRICAL EXHIBITION
HANDBOOK Annual 1923 to 1928. Issued as a catalogue for the exhibitions. Sydney.

RADIO RETAILER OF AUSTRALIA. Monthly, fortnightly, weekly and irregular! Started March 1930 from Mingay Publications but changed to RADIO AND ELECTRICAL MERCHANT in November 1933. In September 1935 it reverted to RADIO RETAILER OF AUSTRALIA and then became RADIO AND ELECTRICAL RETAILER from 25/11/1938. In May 1947 it became RADIO ELECTRICAL WEEKLY series 2. It continues today as MINGAY'S WEEKLY. Sometimes included insert booklets. Sydney.

RADIO EXPERIMENTER Monthly started December 1923 and with the June 1924 issue changed to RADIO EXPERIMENTER AND BROADCASTER. The last issue appears to be June 1925. Vol.2 No.7 but in August 1925 it was absorbed into EXPERIMENTAL RADIO AND BROADCAST NEWS. Melbourne.

THE RADIOGRAM. Monthly started November 1929 for AWA and continued till at least Vol.3 No.10 in 1933. Sydney.

RADIO AND HOME. Started 1/11/1933 but after only 7 issues was absorbed without trace into WESTERN AUSTRALIAN GARDENER Perth

RADIO IN AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND.

Fortnightly started 4/4/1923 to replace the monthly SEA LAND AND AIR. Often called just **RADIO**. After the 13/4/1927, Vol.4 No.106 issue, it changed to a monthly with a new Volume 1 No.1 on 15/5/27. The last issue was 15/12/1928, Vol.2 No.8, it was then absorbed into WIRELESS WEEKLY. Sydney.

RADIO JOURNAL OF AUSTRALIA. Weekly started 23/11/1927 and ceased 28/3/28. Sydney.

RADIO MONTHLY. Monthly started 15/12/1931 and not to be confused with Popular Radio Monthly. The last issue known is 25/5/1934, Vol.3 No.15. Sydney.

RADIO PICTORIAL OF AUSTRALIA. Monthly started July 1935 to at least February 1952, Vol.17 No.8. Sydney.

RADIO PROGRAMS. Weekly started 23/6/1927 and later changed name to **RADIO-PROGRAM PICTORIAL.** Published by POPULAR HOBBIES. Melbourne.

RADIO RESEARCH BOARD REPORTS. No.1 was released in 1931 with others at irregular intervals till 1960. Sydney.

RADIO REVIEW OF AUSTRALIA. Monthly started 17/4/1931. The October 1931 issue changed to TELEVISION AND RADIO REVIEW and then with the December '31, Vol.1 No.8 issue it became TELEVISION AND RADIO REVIEW OF AUSTRALIA. It ceased with the issue of January '32, Vol.1 No.9 but twelve months later was resurrected as RADIO REVIEW OF AUSTRALIA second series starting January 1933. After the June 1938 Vol.6 No.6 issue it was incorporated in RADIO RETAILER OF AUSTRALIA. Sydney.

RADIO SCIENCE. Monthly started February 1948 and ceased with September/October 1949, Vol.2 No.9 issue. • Sydney.

RADIO TRADER. Monthly circa 1938. Melbourne.

RADIO TRADE ANNUAL AND SERVICE MANUAL Annual 1933 to 1939. I am not sure if a 1938 edition was published. Also known as the RADIO TRADE ANNUAL OF AUSTRALIA or RADIO TRADE ANNUAL AND DIRECTORY OF AUSTRALIA or the RADIOTRON TRADE ANNUAL. Sydney.

RADIOTRON TRADE ANNUAL. This is in fact the RADIO TRADE ANNUAL AND SERVICE MANUAL but because AWA advertised their "Radiotron" brand on the

spine of the annual it is often mistakenly identified as the RADIOTRON TRADE ANNUAL. Sydney.

RADIOTRONICS. Monthly but slightly irregular started around 1932 and continued to 1965 when it became a quarterly till around 1969. Sydney.

RADIOVISION. Monthly started September 1928 and ceased October 1929. Melbourne.

SEA LAND AND AIR Monthly started 15/3/1918 (not 1922) and continued till the March 1923 issue, Vol.6 No.60. It was replaced by RADIO IN AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND on 4/4/23. Sydney.

SHORT WAVE RADIO NEWS. Circa 1933-36, Sydney.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA WIRELESS & RADIO MAGAZINE. Initially published as SOUTH AUSTRALIA WIRELESS (MONTHLY) & RADIO MAGAZINE on 1/4/1924 the word (MONTHLY) was deleted on subsequent issues. On 1/1/1925 it became SOUTH AUSTRALIA WIRELESS & RADIO WEEKLY but alter the 12/1/27 issue, Vol.3 No.114 it was incorporated in a new weekly magazine called MODERN RADIO & ELECTRONICS

from 19/1/1927, which ceased with the issue of 4/4/1928, Vol.2 No.63. Adelaide.

TELERADIO. Weekly started May 1933 and appears to have ceased with Vol.9 No.49 of March 1942. Brisbane.

THE TRANSMITTER. Monthly started June 14, 1890. Last copy seen is Vol.18 No.3 of 1908. Sydney. (Has some very early wireless info.)

TV AND RADIO REVIEW. Circa 1931, Sydney.

TRADE-IN HANDBOOK. Annual. Mingay. Sydney. Known issues are:

WAVETRAP. Nothing known except the name.

WEST AUSTRALIAN WIRELESS NEWS & MUSICAL WORLD. Fortnightly started on 9/9/1929 and was renamed WEST AUSTRALIAN WIRELESS NEWS in 1933 and then in September 1936 it became a weekly. The issue of 5/9/36, Vol.7 No.183 became W.A. WIRELESS and WATTLE LEAVES, WATTLE LEAVES was a children's wireless club magazine which had run for about 6 months to Vol.2 No.31, prior to being incorporated in this magazine. Perth.

WESTERN WIRELESS. Fortnightly started 10/10/1923 and ceased 31/8/27, Vol.5 No.99. Perth.

WHO'S WHO IN BROADCASTING (in Western Australia). Annual first published 1933 or 1934 with a second edition for 1935-36. Perth.

WIA BULLETIN. Monthly probably started July 1929 and continuing in February 1932, but longevity unknown. Perth.

WIRELESS CALL. Weekly started 19/2/1924 and ceased 16/1/25, Vol.1 No.5. Sydney.

WIRELESS NEWS. Daily paper produced on ships. Started 4/5/1923 on RMS "Niagara" and extended to other passenger carrying ships. It was replaced by OCEAN NEWS in 1932.

WIRELESS WEEKLY also known as just W.W. Weekly started on 4/8/1922 and continued till the 4/7/1942 issue which said it was THE NEW WIRELESS WEEKLY (I can't see any differences). The last issue was 16/1/1943 but it was incorporated in POCKET BOOK (Wireless Weekly) which was later changed to POCKET BOOK WEEKLY (Story Teller Magazine) and continued till late 1948. At various times Wireless Weekly included insert booklets. Sydney.

WIRELESS WEEKLY CALL SIGN BOOK AND TECHNICAL REVIEW. Known by the 1938 edition but I am not sure if there were prior or later editions. Resurrected in 1947 by Radio and Hobbies when it published the annual AUSTRALIAN SHORT WAVE HANDBOOK from 1947. Sydney.

BOOKS and BOOKLETS.

THE ALL ELECTRIC RECEIVER by VK-3GT.

Published in 1930 by the Listener In, probably as No. 3 in a series of 16 books. Melbourne.

AUSTRALIAN RADIO CALLS. June 1926. Melbourne.

AUSTRALIAN TELECOMMUNICATIONS AT WAR 2/5/1946 as Vol.23 No.16 of RADIO & ELECTRICAL

RETAILER to commemorate and illustrate the use of Australian wireless, radar and telephone equipment in WW2. Sydney.

A.W.A. As you can imagine the company published a number of promotional and technical booklets. Some were obviously issued to influence public and political opinion at times when AWA was pushing its proposals, or in some trouble. I probably don't have them all, but those known are:

A BOOKLET OF CALL SIGNS. A Wireless Weekly insert booklet November 27 1931. Sydney.

BOYS WIRELESS BOOK. A large picture book published in 1924 by Eagle Press, but obviously a reprint of a UK book, with drawings and photos of early English wireless. Sydney.

BY WIRELESS. The story of the first Army wireless messages in Australia, 1910. I think it was published in 1912. Sydney.

CHRISTMAS SUPPLEMENT 1936 - to Radio Retailer, Mingay, Sydney.

CONCISE RADIO HANDBOOK. March 1933. Sydney.

EVENING NEWS WIRELESS HANDBOOK. 1924. Sydney.

HOW TO BUILD A DUAL WAVE SUPERHET. A well produced book for Radiokes, circa early 1930's. Sydney.

LEVENSON'S RADIO "THE BUYERS GUIDE". 1934. Sydney.

LEVENSON'S RADIO "RADIO CIRCUITS". 1941. A reprint of articles from Radio and Hobbies magazine. Sydney.

LINKING AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND WITH THE PACIFIC ISLANDS BY RADIO TELEGRAPHY.

September 1909. Published by UK based Pacific Radiotelegraph Co. to promote its proposals for wireless stations in Australia and the Pacific area. This booklet may have been printed in UK.

RADIO BROADCAST EQUIPMENT IN NSW.

Sub-titled "Progress since 1929" this is a paper published by the Postal Institute of NSW. Sydney.
